- Assistance with fees and books



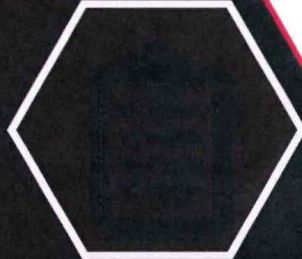
WORK
